

**The project « Zsadany and Tinca building the future of Europe through volunteering » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**Participation:** The project involved 360 citizens, notably 180 participants from the city of Zsadany, Hungary, 180 participants from the city of Tinca, Romania.

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in Zsadany, Hungary from 09/09/2017 to 10/09/2017.

**Short description:**

The self-governing commune of Zsadany (Hungary) has organized a meeting held in their town on September 9-10, 2017 together with its twinned town, Tinca (Romania). The event had the main aim of bringing closer and strengthening the relationships between the two towns from Romania and Hungary at the level of the citizens, companies and local governments. The project theme was Understanding and building the future of Europe through promoting volunteering, tolerance and intercultural dialogue at the level of the twinned towns, Zsadany and Tinca.

6. Cultural programs for encouraging intercultural dialog and tolerance
